LV REFLECTIONS

I can't help but laugh looking back at my three years at San Miguel School in Washington, D.C. Here I was, a shy, recent college graduate, scared about joining a program that would put me front and center of a room full of middle school boys...But, it has been quite a turnaround!



In these past three years, I have learned how to become a strict, albeit caring, teacher and mentor. I believe that is because of my experience as a Lasallian Volunteer, which taught me the power of

communication, the foundation for trust. In a way, it was my willingness to open up to my community members that truly helped me open up to my students. The idea of living with strangers (including a Christian Brother!) was very overwhelming. Yet, it was through casual conversations during dinner, during morning and evening prayer, or during spiritual talks in our faith sharing that I found my voice. I was learning so much about faith and the Lasallian charism, which helped me learn more about myself; most importantly, it helped me understand others. It was through this experience that I got to see God in my actions, in my students' actions, and in our mishaps. This vision was the driving force behind my motivation to see my students for what they are: children with a voice! I no longer viewed them as simple students, but rather as people with ideas and creativity that shouldn't be masked because of my inept lack of awareness. I have grown tremendously since I started as a Lasallian Volunteer, and I can't help to think that it truly has been through faith, service and community. I'm still learning about my students, and they're learning about me. It is this bond that pushes me to be a better teacher, friend, colleague, son, brother, Lasallian.

Jon Vanegas, LV 16-18, is a faculty member at San Miguel School in Washington, D.C.

"A comfort zone is a beautiful place, but nothing ever grows there." This is the quote that I decided to live by my first year of service. I have no idea where this quote is from or who came up with such a powerful statement, but it has changed my perspective of the world. I grew up in South Memphis which was a low-income area. I always knew that there was so much more in the world outside of the

area that I grew up in. However, it was often difficult to make the decision to make the next big step. I was very nervous and reluctant to become a Lasallian Volunteer but once I saw the quote above during orientation I knew that I had made the right decision. This program has granted me the opportunity to connect with people that I know will turn into lifelong friendships. I have been able to see beautiful sceneries and skylines that I dreamed of growing up. I now have a new support system and



family that I know that I can depend on. Most importantly, I was given the opportunity to reach out to students who have similar backgrounds to myself, to be a presence in their lives and learn things

from them. I still stay in contact with some of those students today. If I never stepped out of that comfort zone I would have been just that, comfortable. However, walking into unknown territory has brought joy, discernment, support and growth. Thank you for helping me grow.

Diana Lockett, LV 16-18, is an LV Scholar at Lewis University in Romeoville, Illinois.

I want to begin by thanking those who support the Lasallian Volunteers. It's through your commitment and generosity that a transformational experience for LVs and students alike is possible. As I reflect on my experience as an LV, I am amazed with not only the powerful impact the program has on students and clients but how it has positively affected my life. When I entered the program, I didn't know what to expect. I knew I was moving across the country to serve at De Marillac Academy in San Francisco, California, which is located in an area that is both socio-economically and culturally different than where I grew up. I went in nervous with my eyes wide open and what I found was nothing short of transformative. I found students who inspire me. They inspire me with their ability to work hard and overcome the many challenges that they face in order to achieve their ultimate goals. In the Tenderloin, I found a neighborhood that defies its stereotypes. The community of Brothers at Sacred Heart Cathedral is willing to sacrifice and support me in anything that I need. More important than all of this, I rediscovered my spirituality, a spirituality that was sorely missing in my



life. Overall, the LV program has provided me with perspectives and experiences that I know will serve as a strong foundation for my future endeavors. As I prepare to begin law school, I am eternally grateful for the lessons I

learned as a Lasallian Volunteer.

Zachary Javorsky, LV 18-19, is a first-year LV serving at De Marillac Academy in San Francisco, California.

Upon my arrival, the associate director, Anne Moscinski, sat down with me in the cafeteria and shared some the knowledge she has acquired in her 38 years at LaSalle School in Albany, New York. She told me that she believes "each person is doing the best they can, with what they have," and "if they are struggling then they are missing something they need." These words are not always easy to remember in stressful situations, but have been instrumental during my time as an admissions worker at



LaSalle School. I am among the first people a new LaSalle student meets during what is most often a difficult transition to our residential treatment center, as youth don't come to us without significant

struggles at school, at home and in the community. Anne's words have become a personal mantra and I keep them at the forefront of my mind when I meet with families to discuss the trauma and struggles they have undoubtedly experienced because they promote at least a moment of patience and self-forgiveness. I have been so fortunate to work with and learn from faculty, staff and students at LaSalle School. The progress I have witnessed, the smiles I have received, and the relationships I have made with our boys have been nothing short of life-changing. My heart is so full.

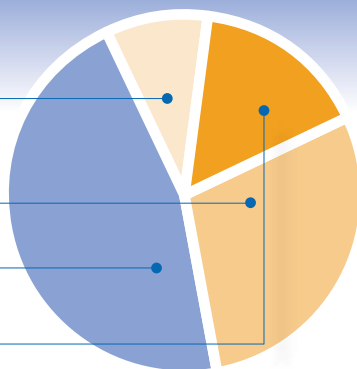

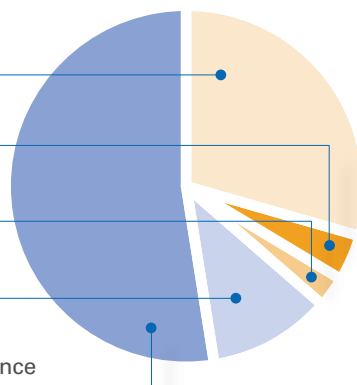

ST. SOLOMON FUND

In 2017, Lasallian Volunteers was awarded \$100,000 to assist with student loan payments after the completion of a successful year as a Lasallian Volunteer. As a means to address low recruitment numbers since the loss of AmeriCorps, which previously awarded educational grants to volunteers at the completion of a service year, funding has been made available to increase student loan support to those interested in serving as an LV.

"Learning about the St. Solomon Fund removed my financial anxiety so I could answer the call to my Lasallian vocation as an LV."

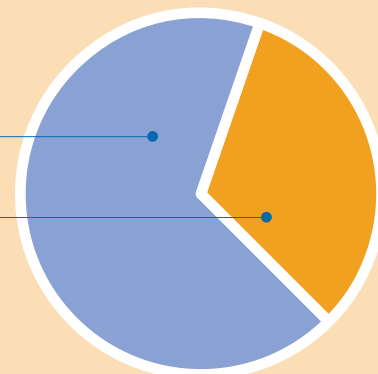
